RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING USE OF CLUB FACILITIES

NO ALCOHOL WILL BE PERMITTED

except at pool sponsored events

SMOKING IS PROHIBITED WITHIN THE FENCED IN POOL GROUNDS. SMOKING IS ONLY PERMITTED IN THE DESGINATED AREA.

NO GLASSWARE OR BRITTLE HARD PLASTIC OF ANY KIND WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA.

ADMISSION

- 1. ONLY members and their guests will be admitted to Club facilities. Members as defined by the Club by-Laws include Resident and Associate members.
- 2. Admittance to the pool will be through self-identification as a member and a check of the membership roster by the Lifeguard stationed at the front gate.
- 3. A guest entry ledger will be at the front gate. The member MUST complete the required information in the guest ledger for each guest.
- 4. Members are not permitted to bring more than six (6) guests in any one day. Members are responsible for their guests' compliance with all pool Rules and Regulations.
- 5. All parties must be scheduled with Pool Management at least 2 weeks in advance. There is a 25 person limit for all parties.
- 6. Children under 10 years of age, member or guest, must be accompanied by their parents or a member 14 years of age or older for admission to the pool. This person MUST REMAIN with the children during the entire time the children are at the pool.
- 7. Babysitters, whose names are shown on the family's membership, may be admitted to the pool only to perform their duties as a babysitter. The babysitter's children may come as a paying guest when the babysitter is performing his/her duties.
- 8. Pool management may restrict admittance to the pool at any time for health or safety reasons.

SWIMMING POOL

No one under the age of 18 will be permitted in any part of the main pool during adult break The balance of the time, children will be allowed in the main pool as long as they are toilet trained. IF THE CHILD IS NOT TOILET TRAINED, THEY WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE MAIN POOL ONLY WITH SWIM DIAPERS COVERED BY RUBBER PANTS. THESE MUST BE WORN THE ENTIRE TIME THE CHILD IS IN THE MAIN POOL. Swim diapers and rubber pants will be available for purchase at the manager's office.

- 1. Only proper type bathing or swim suits are permissible. Cutoffs are not allowed in the pool.
- 2. All bathers should shower before entering the pool.
- 3. The use of kickboards, tubes, rafts and all other swimming equipment will be regulated by the Pool Manager and Lifeguards.
- 4. All swimmers under 18 years of age must observe the 15 minute rest period (adult break) which may be held each hour on the hour.
- 5. The only safety devices that may be used by children are water wings and vest. A PARENT OR ADULT MUST REMAIN WITH THE CHILD IN THE WATER AT ALL TIMES WHILE WATER WINGS AND VESTS ARE BEING USED. No safety devices or goggles are allowed on the slide at any time.

- 6. Only children who can demonstrate their swimming ability to the Pool Management satisfaction will be permitted to swim in the diving well.
- 7. When weather conditions dictate, the pool will be closed in the interest of safety. Pool Management shall have the authority to affect the closing.
- 8. The pool will be cleared of all people in the event of an emergency. The signal for this will be 3 blasts of the Lifequard's whistle.
- 9. Strict adherence to the direction of the Lifeguards must be maintained at all times.

KIDDIE POOL

Although the kiddie pool will have a lifeguard on duty, PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR WATCHING THEIR CHILDREN.

- 1. The kiddie pool is intended for the use of children 6 years of age and younger.
- 2. Children must wear proper bathing attire. (Swim diapers are permitted ONLY with plastic pants).
- 3. The kiddie pool will be open only when covered by a lifeguard.

GENERAL RULES

- 1. All personal injuries, HOWEVER SLIGHT, must be reported to the Pool Manager.
- 2. The Management assumes no responsibility for accident or injury resulting from individual negligence, as well as, for loss or damage of personal property.
- 3. Property damages or other expenses arising from violation of these rules by members, members' children, or members' guest will be charged to the member responsible.
- 4. Activities will not be permitted which disturb the safety or enjoyment of others. Riding of bicycles, scooters, motorbikes, motor scooters, motorcycles, skateboards, roller skates, or rollerblades are not allowed on pool grounds. Games in the pool or on the grounds can be controlled or restricted by pool staff.
- 5. RUNNING, PUSHING, ROUGHNESS OR UNDISCIPLINED CONDUCT IS PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES. (i.e., chicken fights, water tag)
- 6. Use of equipment for games must be approved by POOL MANAGEMENT. Foosball, basketball, and table tennis are available. The equipment for these games will be kept at the office and signed out by the pool staff. Users of the equipment shall be responsible for damage to the equipment.
- 7. Strollers, baby carriages and playpens are not permitted within 10 feet of the pool.
- 8. No chewing gum is permitted in the pool area.
- 9. Eating is not permitted within 5 feet of the pool.
- 10. ALL trash must be deposited in the receptacles provided.
- 11. No pets of any kind will be permitted in the pool area.
- 12. The pool office and office phone are for the POOL STAFF and FOR OFFICIAL BUSINESS ONLY.
- 13. The entrance way is to be kept clear at all times. NO LOITERING IS PERMITTED AT THE FRONT GATE.
- 14. There will be absolutely NO PARKING in the loading area (yellow line on curb). This area is specifically designated a "no parking" zone for emergencies and pool supply deliveries only.
- 15. The Management and/or Board of Trustees reserves the right to determine when to suspend or revoke a membership or remove any person (member or guest) for inappropriate, obnoxious or offensive behavior and/or language.
